



City of San Antonio admits they've "tweaked" the signal timing on 281!

You may have noticed a marked increase in the wait time at the traffic signals on 281 since the toll project was halted (adding 20-30 minutes to commute times). Many of our supporters inquired with Commissioner Lyle Larson who asked the City for information. At the last MPO Transportation Meeting, Jan. 23, 2006, Christina De La Cruz in Public Works admitted **they had changed the signal timing** due to new traffic counts from TxDOT. Turns out in a letter to Larson, the City Planner states that, in fact, traffic counts have stayed the same recently. **So the City and TxDOT are purposely politicizing our highway system AND STEALING YOUR VALUABLE TIME!**
